UPDATE: COVID-19 Procedure/Surgery Assessment form–Adult Patients

What is New?

Update of the KYI sent June 17th for the Perioperative Network implementation of the Covid19 Pre-Procedure/Surgery Assessment – Adult form as per [BCCDC Infection Prevention and Control \(IPC\) Protocol for Surgical Procedures During COVID-19: Adult](#) released by the BC Ministry of Health.

NEW: June 28th update to the [Aerosol Generating Procedure \(AGP\) Standard Operating Procedure](#) Fraser Health, where CPAP and BiPAP are identified as high risk AGPs.

Two additional questions have been added to the 24 to 72 Hours Prior screening portion of the assessment:

- Do you have Obstructive Sleep Apnea yes no

- If yes, direct patient to community clinic for Covid 19 swab
