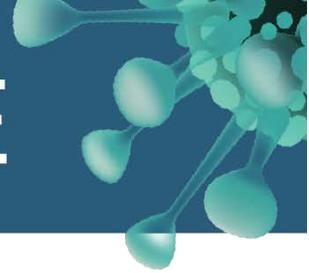

### What's new?

- **New Regional Pre-Printed Order (PPO) for COVID-19 & Other Order Sets**

The Clinical Policy Office today released a new regional [pre-printed order \(PPO\) for COVID-19](#) suspected and confirmed patients. It is now available in Web FormImprint. Medical staff are asked to provide feedback on the form to Dr. Kevin Afra. Please see the [KYI](#) for more info. ## Current status

- As of April 2, 2020, BC has 55 new COVID-19 cases, bringing the total number of cases to 1121 in BC; Fraser Health has 386 positive COVID-19 cases of which 65 are hospitalized including 34 in ICU/HAU.
