

Cardiologist/Heart Failure Director
Surrey, BC

Surrey Memorial Hospital (SMH) is inviting applications for the position of a Heart Failure Director. SMH is located in the Lower Mainland and is part of the Fraser Health Authority. It is the 2nd largest hospital in BC with over 600 beds, and has the busiest ER department in the province. Inpatient cardiology is provided in a 7 bed CCU and a 22 bed telemetry ward. Diagnostic cardiology procedures including echocardiography and nuclear medicine studies are provided both at SMH and the nearby Jim Pattison Outpatient Care and Surgery Centre. Outpatient clinics include Heart Function, Lipid, Pacemaker and Cardiac Rehabilitation clinics.

The Royal Columbian hospital nearby is the closest cardiac catheterization laboratory and the cardiac surgery centre. Currently, the Heart Function Clinic is one of the busiest and well-supported clinics of its kind in the Lower Mainland. It has physician, nursing (RN and nurse practitioner, including NP-led inpatient consult service) and pharmacy support.

The successful applicant will join the Cardiology Department that consists of 13 cardiologists and will participate in the cardiology on-call service, ward service, and electro-diagnostic interpretation (including echocardiography).

The applicant should have additional specialty heart failure training and will be expected to become Director of the Heart Function Clinic. The candidate must have CMPA membership, be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC, and hold a FRCP(C).
