Physician Lead, **Interventional** Clinical Planning Royal Columbian Hospital (RCH) Redevelopment

RCH Redevelopment invites qualified physicians to submit an expression of interest for the role of Physician Lead, Interventional Clinical Planning, RCH Redevelopment. This role will provide strategic and operational medical leadership with respect to clinical planning for the Interventional Platform. The individual will have a close collaborative relationship with the Physician Lead, Clinical Planning (Overall Project) and the Director, Clinical Planning & Capital Projects and will make recommendations for evidence-based, innovative, patient-centred best practices to enhance future redevelopment of this platform. The role will provide guidance to meaningful engagement of physician partners and to achieving success in impacting clinical outcomes through the redevelopment of the interventional platform that includes the operating rooms, interventional cardiology and radiology, procedure rooms, anesthesia care unit and medical device reprocessing.

The position will foster relationships and work with internal and external physicians, researchers, directors, leaders, contractors and other redevelopment team members. The individual in this role will serve as a key contact and representative of physicians within the interventional platform.

Reporting to the RCH Medical Director and Executive Director, the incumbent will also have a working relationship with the Project Executive Sponsor in relation to the RCH redevelopment interventional areas. This is a part-time role estimated to require an average of 1-2 days per week.

Major responsibilities (within the Interventional areas only) will include:

1. Clinical planning and management: Review of current RCH clinical services, volumes and practices as a baseline for a population-based, patient-centred future state clinical service delivery plan.
2. Provide opportunities for the active engagement and involvement of physicians and academic and research leaders in the development and implementation of the future state clinical service delivery plan and performance specifications for design of Phase 2/3.
3. Act as the dyad partner to the Director of Surgical services.
4. Incorporate the concepts outlined as clinical benefits in the business case.
5. Integration of all clinical, clinical support and clinical administrative service planning for the entire interventional platform.
6. Provide accountability for the clinical service delivery plan and performance specifications within this platform.
7. Develop terms of reference and governance documents for the integration of all these areas.

Qualifications

- Physician licensed to practice in British Columbia
- Eligible for appointment as a member of the Medical Staff for RCH
- A minimum of 5 years medical leadership experience or equivalent
- Interest in development of leadership expertise
