

Medical Lead(er), Research, Learning and Innovation, Fraser Health

The Medical Lead(er) is a passionate, relational-based physician administrator and leader who works to sustain strong, collaborative working relationships between teams, communities and external partners. The role provides strategic medical leadership to develop a vision, lead the strategy, and ensure the planning, coordination, integration, operation, and evaluation of Fraser Health's Learning, Research and Innovation program; including the creation of a new medical school in partnership with Simon Fraser University (SFU) and First Nations Health Authority (FNHA).

The Medical Lead(er) will have a close collaborative relationship with the Executive Director, Research, Learning and Innovation, the Vice President, Patient Experience as well as the academic and research communities.

This is a part-time role estimated to require an average of 2 days per week.

KEY AREAS OF INVOLVEMENT

The Medical Lead(er) will work closely with SFU and FNHA to develop the medical school will lead the way in medical education that models an understanding of Indigeneity, including cultural safety and humility and decolonized, holistic health care. The partnership will build an approach to health education with a focus on primary care, inter-professional practice and the provision of safe, culturally competent care. Faculty, students, and programming will reflect the communities its serves (e.g., diverse Indigenous peoples, refugee and newcomer communities etc.).

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Leads work with key stakeholders including Ministry of Health and Ministry of Advanced Education.
- Collaborate effectively with internal and external stakeholders to develop, manage and evaluate programs/services within a complex environment and to advance strategic transformation initiatives.
- Co-lead the community consultation and engagement process for the creation of Fraser Health/SFU/FNHA Medical School including co-creating the partnerships and integration across the health authorities with the existing medical school at UBC and the proposed SFU medical school.

- Support SFU's understanding of the health human resources needs within the Fraser Health Region and province from both an Indigenous and non-Indigenous health outcomes perspective for integration into the curriculum development.
- Integrate medical education as a standard in primary care clinics and networks and provides clear pathways to graduates into internships, residencies, and training for medical student supervisors.
- Address effective cultural preparation proactively for medical doctors in the future and continues to work toward reconciliation, Indigeneity, intercultural sensitivity and awareness and decolonizing health practices across the health authority.

REPORTING RELATIONSHIP

The role reports jointly to the Vice President, Patient Experience and the Vice President, Medicine.

TERM

The term will be a two-year term renewable upon satisfactory performance reviews and by mutual agreement of all parties if desired.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Current licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of British Columbia
- Eligibility for membership on the Fraser Health medical staff
- A minimum of 10 years medical leadership experience or equivalent
- Experience in the development of medical school and/or residency program is highly desirable
