

Upon completion of the process for assessment and provision of medical assistance in dying, the prescribing physician (or originating physician if patient is found to be ineligible) is to submit all required documentation to the following:

- 1. Medical Assistance in Dying - Record of Patient Request
- 2. Medical Assistance in Dying - Record of Assessment (Prescriber)
- 3. Medical Assistance in Dying - Record of Assessment (Assessor)
- 4. Medical Assistance in Dying - Consultant Assessment of Patient's Informed Consent Decision Capability (if an assessment was requested)
- 5. Medical Assistance in Dying – Prescription (including Medication Administration Record for Oral Regimen and/or Intravenous Regimen)
- 6. Other documents the physician(s) considers to be relevant.
- 7. BC Coroners Service Report of MAiD Death
