Patient Eligibility Criteria:

1. If a patient requests MAiD what would be your approach?
2. What are the eligibility criteria for MAiD?
3. What other options would you discuss?
4. How would you assess capacity to make a medical decision?
5. What would you do if you had doubt regarding capacity?
6. What does a voluntary decision mean?
7. What must you advise the patient regarding their request for MAiD?
8. If you have any questions who do you call?

Reducing Conflict of Interest:

1. Who can and cannot be a witness to the Request?
2. What must be the relationship between the physician and the patient?
3. How do we reduce conflict of interest between the two physicians?

Documentation Required for MAiD:

1. Which documents must be completed?
2. How would you complete the death certificate after MAiD?
3. Where must copies of the documents be sent once completed?

Provision of MAiD:

1. How and when would you involve the pharmacist in the process?
2. Can you walk me through considerations in deciding on the oral route?
3. What complications could occur?
4. How would you address these complications?
5. What would be the backup plan?
6. Can you walk me through the intravenous route?
7. What complications could occur?
8. How would you address these complications?
9. What would you do with unused medication?

What must you ask the patient before giving the medication?

Can you leave the patient while providing MAiD?

After MAiD how will you debrief?
