

<b>Lung Health, Lung Rehabilitation, and Lung Diagnostics</b>	
<b>Service &amp; Target Population</b>	<p><u>Lung Health</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For patients with known chronic lung disease (i.e. asthma, COPD, IPF) that is not well managed</li> </ul> <p><u>Lung Rehabilitation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For patients with stable chronic lung disease (i.e. fixed asthma, COPD, IPF, pre transplant, post transplant)</li> </ul> <p><u>Lung Diagnostics</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Lung Diagnostics (formerly known as the Pulmonary Function Lab) provided for Surrey residents from 17 years of age and up. Pediatric lung diagnostics will continue to be available at Surrey Memorial Hospital. All bookings will be done through the Outpatient Centre.</li> </ul>
<b>Services</b>	<p><u>Lung Health</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Service: Confirm diagnosis of lung disease, investigate co-morbid disease, optimize treatment, improve patient self management skills, and provide smoking cessation support.</li> </ul> <p><u>Lung Rehabilitation</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Service: 6 week, 12 session program</li> <li>Patients attend a pre-program assessment visit</li> <li>Emphasizes health improvement and self-management skills through a combination of education and exercise.</li> <li>Patients are offered a second 6 week, 12 session exercise-only program upon completion of their first session.</li> <li>All programs are delivered using a multi-disciplinary model and are coordinated by the respiratory outpatient services department.</li> </ul>
<b>Service Highlights</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Adult Asthma Clinic (part of Lung Health) has received awards of unrestricted educational grants on multiple occasions in recognition of the comprehensive model of care provided to patients with asthma.</li> <li>Work is currently underway through partnerships in Fraser Health and Vancouver Coastal to develop a care pathway and discharge plans for patients with COPD which may refer patients to a Respiratory Therapist Educator.</li> <li>The Lung Rehabilitation Program developed a partnership with the Tong Louie Family YMCA in 2004. This is the first community partnership of its kind for Lung Rehabilitation in BC. Other community partnerships of this kind have been developed using this model.</li> <li>Lung diagnostics provides diagnostic services including specialized testing for pediatric clients not available elsewhere in Fraser Health.</li> </ul>
