Service & Target Population	The Renal Vascular Access and Follow-up Clinic focuses on the renal patients' vascular access needs from the time of assessed need (3 months prior to maturation) through the entire life of the access including treatment and follow-up using an algorithm of best practice and involving a multidisciplinary team of practitioners.
Services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • assesses new patients without access • provides assessment and follow-up for new patients with access • provides assessment and follow-up for patients with established vascular access • elective and urgent (non-emergent) vascular access surgical and IR procedures • coordinate appropriate interventions as per the recommendations or orders of the nephrologists, surgeons or interventional radiologists • coordinate and provide care of multiple providers on multiple sites as a single team for patients who require access assessment: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ new referrals ○ follow-up of new access creations ○ follow-up and treatment of established access creations
