The Physician Quality Improvement (PQI) is seeking a Physician QI Advisor on a part-time basis.

The Specialist Services Committee (SSC) was formed in 2006 under the Physician Master Agreement to help the Doctors of BC, BC government and health authorities collaborate on the delivery of specialist services and support improvement of the specialist care system in BC. Through technical resources and expertise, PQI provides training and support to physicians, help lead QI projects that build QI capacity. PQI aims to increase physician involvement in QI and enhances the delivery of quality patient care.

Reporting to the FH PQI Joint Steering Committee and with additional accountability for deliverables to the SSC, the PQI Advisor participates in the planning, development, implementation and evaluation of PQI throughout Fraser Health, and ensures services of PQI program within FH are aligned with the criteria as determined by the Joint FH PQI Steering Committee and FH strategic priorities.
