### Provincial Violence Prevention Curriculum

### Violence Prevention – PVPC for Physicians

- This 1.5 hour course is a version of the Provincial Violence Prevention Curriculum (PVPC) e-learning that has been modified to be suitable for medical staff, including physicians, medical residents, midwives, nurse practitioners, and dentists. It covers the same competencies as the standard PVPC seven e-learning modules but through the eyes of the physician. It is therefore considered to be an equivalent.
- This course will be a pre-requisite for the PVPC for Physicians Classroom course scheduled for 2024 in Fraser Health.

### Violence Prevention – PVPC for Physicians Classroom (Coming in 2024)

- This practical, hands-on 3.5 hour classroom session provides opportunities to practice key violence prevention strategies and builds on the skills learned in [the Violence Prevention – PVPC for Physicians e-learning course](#).
- This course is the classroom component of the violence prevention curriculum for medical staff, including physicians, medical residents, nurse practitioners, dentists, and midwives. All participants must complete the pre-requisites prior to attending the course.
- If you have completed the PVPC seven e-learning modules for health care staff, this is considered equivalent to the [pre-requisites](#) outlined for this course.
