We are seeking an innovative physician to join our team as an Associate Site Medical Director (ASMD) for Jim Pattison Outpatient Care and Surgery Centre (JPOCSC). The ASMD will help build and support a culture of patient and care-team safety and clinical effectiveness, where the patient and family are the centre of clinical system design. Your leadership will help us move complex change across our health service system to support broad transformation objectives. As a consensus builder, you lead by example and understand how to address site needs within the broader context of the health delivery system and multiple service delivery requirements. If this work sparks excitement within you, we welcome you to join our collaborative team.

JPOCSC is located on the traditional, ancestral and unceded territories of the Katzie, Kwantlen, Kwikwetlem Semiahmoo and Tsawwassen First Nations, and home to the Surrey-Delta Métis Association.

JPOCSC provides a full range of scheduled outpatient services including day surgery, diagnostic services and specialized health clinics. It features over 100 examination rooms and six operating rooms, more than 50 clinics, including the world-renowned Breast Health Clinic, a comprehensive medical imaging floor with two MRIs, including a donor-supported new 3Tesla MRI and a pain management facility which treats 800 patients a month.

The ASMD based on shared accountabilities with the Site Medical Director (SMH) and the Executive Director (ED) at JPOCSC, is responsible for coordination and direction of care and patient access and transitions in order to deliver quality patient centred care across the care continuum.

This position reports to the Vice President, Regional Hospitals and Health Services with professional accountability to the Vice President Medicine.



## **Key Areas of Involvement:**

### **Leadership and Operations**

- Provide leadership through mentoring, coaching, and modelling a collaborative working style and leading by influence and respect.
- With the SMD and ED, share decision making and accountability for JPOCSC operations and delivery of quality patient centred care.
- Provide leadership to support and coordinate the requirements of programs operating within JPOCSC (connecting with regional program leaders as required), and escalate clinical delivery issues as necessary.
- In collaboration with the SMD and ED, identify and advocate for JPOCSC specific needs in partnership with Regional Medical Directors (RMD)'s and community organizations.
- In collaboration with the SMD and ED, and in conjunction with relevant regional program and regional medical leadership, ensure that medical services at the JPOCSC are delivered effectively within the established Clinical Service Plans.
- Co-chair with the SMD and ED, JPOCSC based committees including but not limited to Health Care Quality and Operations Management Committee, Access and Flow, and the Quality Committee and ensure its compliance with their terms of reference.
- Represent the JPOCSC as requested by the VP responsible for the hospital.

### **Qualifications:**

- Eligibility for membership on the Fraser Health Medical Staff
- Five (5) years' leadership experience within the healthcare sector
- A Master's degree in health administration or business administration is preferred and experience in hospital-based leadership is highly desirable
- Additional leadership training is preferred.
- Experience with budgetary and operational planning is desirable.
